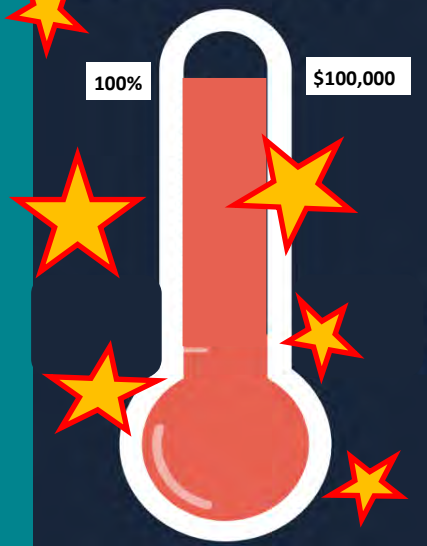

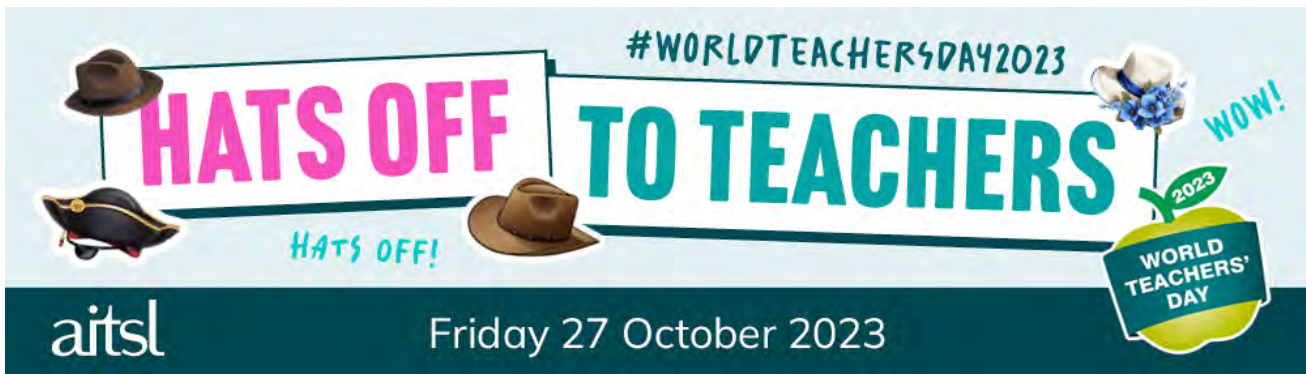

We traced around ourselves to create a class of paper people and then used informal units to measure our length.






We needed to use a uniform unit (the same).

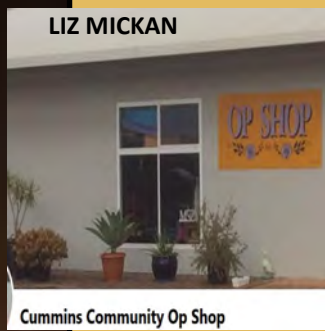
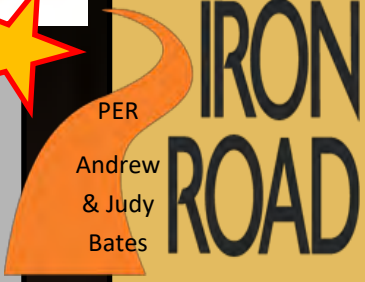
